Visitation will be Sunday, July 26th, from 12:30 p.m. until time of service at Rainey-Mathis Funeral Home in Dexter.

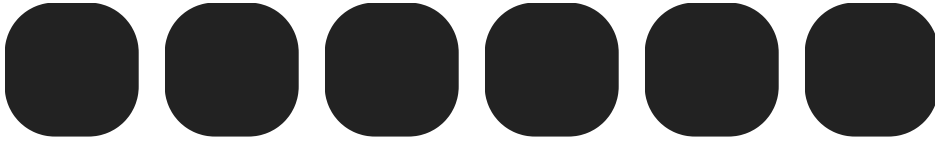
The funeral service will be at 1:30 p.m. at the funeral home with Rev. Dennis Ward officiating. Burial will follow in Dexter Cemetery.

Funeral Services will follow at 10:00 a.m. at the Chiles-Cooper Funeral Home in Bloomfield, Missouri.

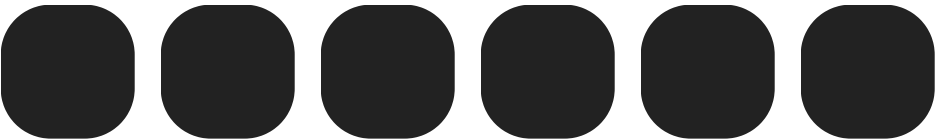

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Peggy L. Rangel.

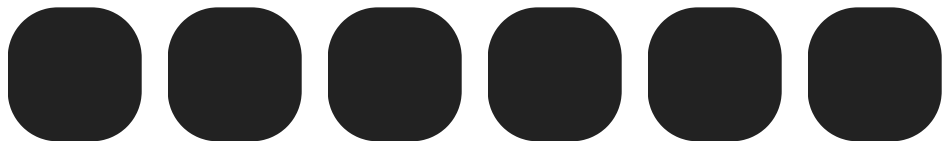

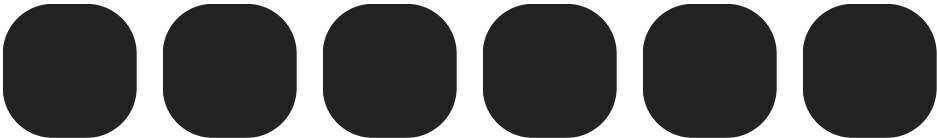
