"Each day children will be challenged through the various "core" preschool subjects of numbers, letters and phonics," Hester said. "As well as the Bible, music, art, character education and healthy habits – this is an all inclusive curriculum that we are excited to offer to our prospective students."

"We are also in the process of getting setup to take infants and toddlers," commented Hester.
