"We are just incredibly grateful for the support from the Friends of the Library," continued Trammell.

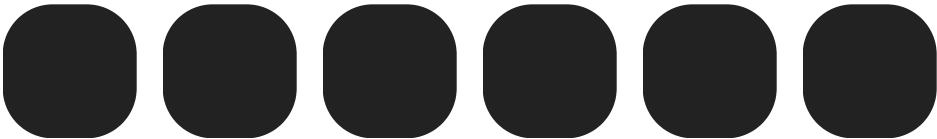
The Friends of the Library raises funds throughout the year for programs and services beyond the scope of the library, including their largest fundraiser the annual Fashion Show.

Kick-off is at 7:00 p.m. against the New Madrid County Central Eagles! Let's clip those wings BEARCATS!!!!

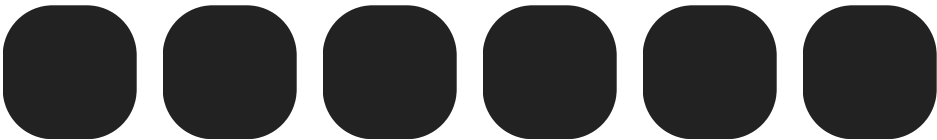
The Bearcat Event Center is the place to be prior to the football game! Get psyched up and cheer for our boys of fall!
