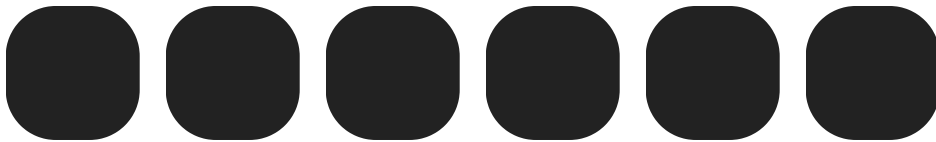

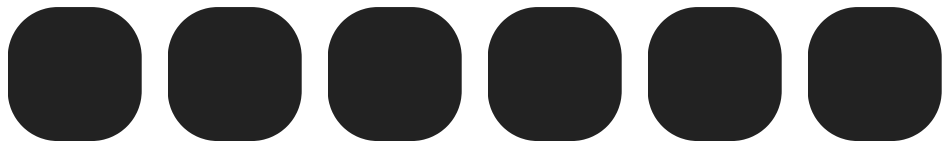
Stop in and admire all the beautiful quilts designed by area quilters. There will also be unique items to purchase at the Heartland Quilters' Creative Boutique.
