He has participated in Dexter Bearcat Football his sophomore, junior, and senior years of high school.

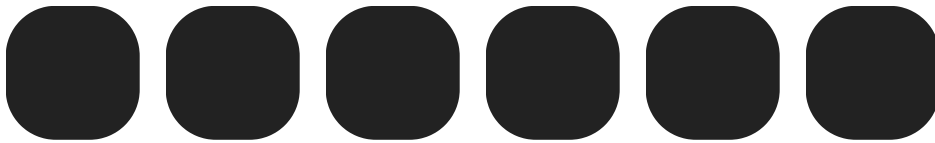
Austin plans to join the Navy after high school graduation.

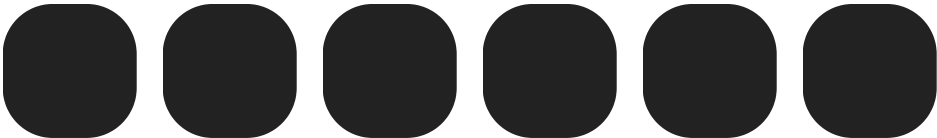
Through this program, Walmart is providing over \$4.5 million to more than 90,000 teachers across the country for the 2015-2016 school year.
