She was preceded in death by one sister, Esther L. McClananhan.

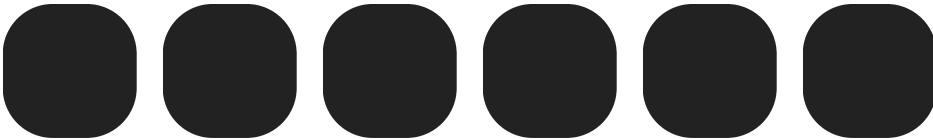
