Old-fashioned names are again on their way up, with Aurora, Caroline, Cecelia, Eleanor, Grace, Hazel, Lillian, Penelope and Vera all on the list for girls in 2015, and Alexander, Emmett, Henry, James, Joel, Milo, Rodney and Zeke on the boys' list. For boys, firearms seemed to be another trend, with names like Colt, Gauge, Garrison, Sterling and Winchester appearing on the list.
