Ten contestants raised \$740 for the JR Beta Club and the dance netted over \$1,500. Those students worked very hard and had a great time.

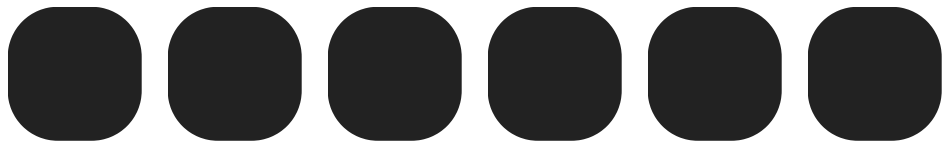

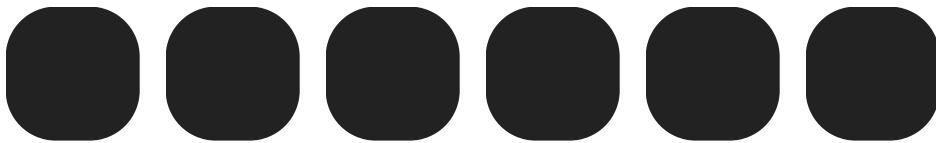
