Mr. Leathers worked as a truck driver for Woody's Trucking and was a resident of Dexter.

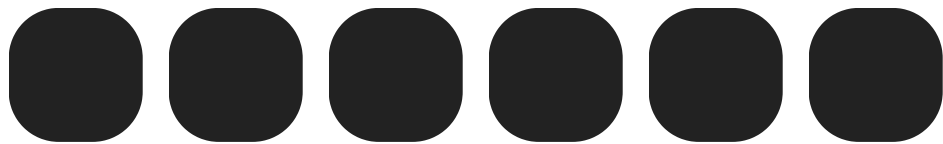
