Funeral services will be conducted in the Rainey-Mathis Funeral Chapel on Friday, March

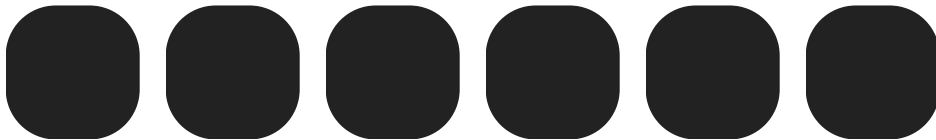

On November 11, 1987, she was united in marriage to Mark Dwayne King in Idalia, Missouri. Mr. King survives of the home.

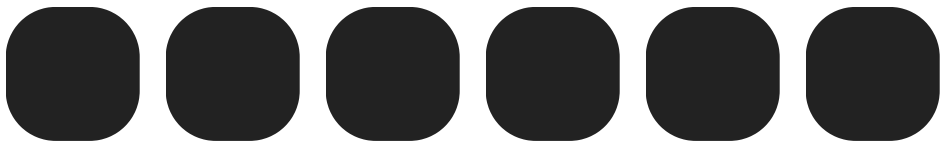
