Call to Order/Roll Call/Pledge The Board President announced the meeting is to begin, all members were present except for Rick Williams and Mark Nea, the president then lead in the saying of the Pledge of Allegiance.

- **4.** <u>Consent Agenda</u> The (Amended) Consent Agenda was approved; the minutes from February 16thwere approved. Motion carried 5-0
- 5. Public Comments

CTA – Mrs. Jarrell spoke on their retirement tea scheduled for April 28th and the Board Candidate Q & A forum, she stated that all candidates couldn't attend the forum so they are giving them questions and placing them in the Daily Statesman and on the ShowMe Times.

Correspondence – A thank you note from the Bell family was read thanking the board and staff.

The students had attended a Tobacco Free Missouri Youth Rally in Jefferson City and then visited the Capitol building.


