Ethan Flowers lost to Pembroke Hill's Josh Bortnick in his Round of 16 match 6-0, 6-0 at the double elimination tournament. Flowers also dropped his consolation match to Jasen Neyer of Springfield Catholic 6-2, 6-2. He finished his season with an impressive record of 17-7 in singles.

Zach Potts and Joshua Kohlbaker suffered a 6-1, 6-1 loss to Logan Rogersville's James Ethridge and Jack Gold in their Round of 16 match. Potts and Kohlbaker came back with a 6-1, 4-6, 10-7 win over Maryville's Joseph Suchan and Trystan Lyle in their first round consolation match. They then suffered a season ending 6-1, 6-2 loss to Kyle Zimmerschied and Cole Lankford of Knob Noster in the consolation quarterfinal. The finish their season with an impressive record of 23-3 in doubles.

Addison Moore and Tyler Stevenson suffered a 6-2, 6-0 loss to Gavin Litherland and Carson Turner of Greenwood. Moore and Stevenson also dropped thier first round consolation match to Chillicothe's Nathaniel McKiddy and Bradon Lamp 7-6(3), 6-0.

Dexter Lady Cats Qualify for State Track Meet

Kirkwood, Missouri - The Lady Cats Track & Field Team qualified six girls to head to the Class 1 State Track Meet held last Saturday at the Kirkwood High School.

Senior MaKayla Waldner qualified in four events for a second straight year. She finished first in 100 meter hurdles with a time of 15.14 and first in 300 meter hurdles with a time of 43.57. She also placed third in the 200 meter run with a time of 26.17 and fourth in long jump with a distance of 17-1 1/2.

"This is Mak's fourth year to qualify for State," commented mom and Dexter Head Track Coach Kimberly Waldner. "She ran her fastest time this year in the 100 meter hurdles and 300 meter hurdles at sectionals."

Sophomore Madelyn Webb qualified for State for a second straight season in shot put finishing third at the sectional level with a throw of 31-11.

The 4x800 Relay Team placed second with a time of 10:26.59 at Sectionals. Sophomore Emily Ladd, junior Emily Page, sophomore Rhylan Hillis and senior Julia Hahn are also state bound.

The Lady Cats finished third overall in team competition with 67 points. John Burroughs placed first with 145 points and Cardinal Ritter placed second with 88 points.

They will travel to Jefferson City High School for the State Tournament slated for Friday, May 27th and Saturday, May 28th.



His favorite baseball memory was when Raden broke his collarbone.


His favorite baseball player of all time is the infamous Tyler Heil.
