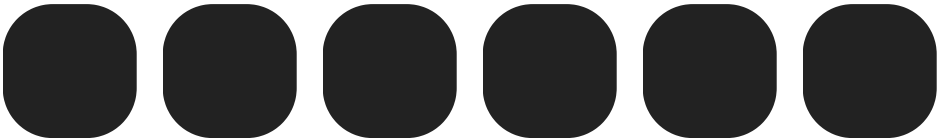
Burial will follow in the Garden of Memories Cemetery in Sikeston.

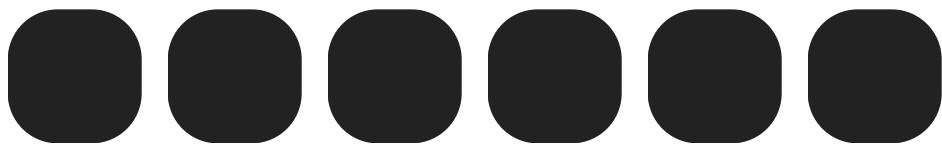

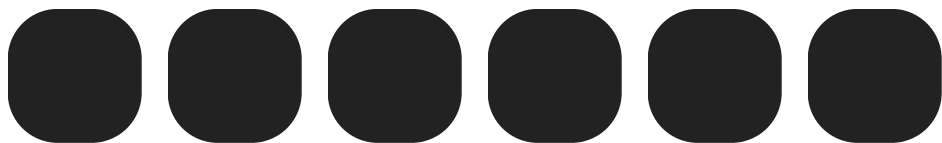
