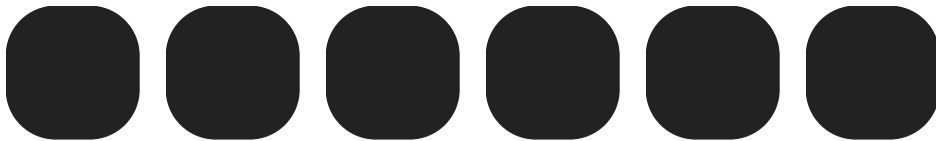

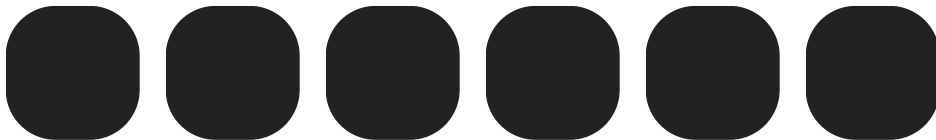

Mrs. Griffey was a past owner of Petite Beauty Salon for 35 years, owner of Royal One Stop, and a resident of Dexter.

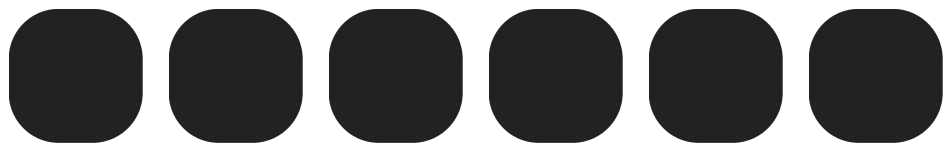
