Farmers Market in Bloomfield

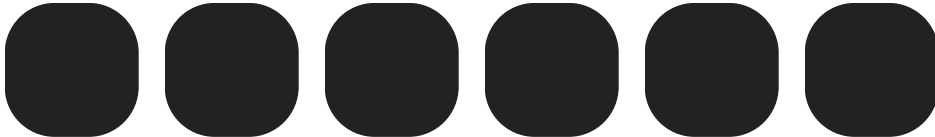
