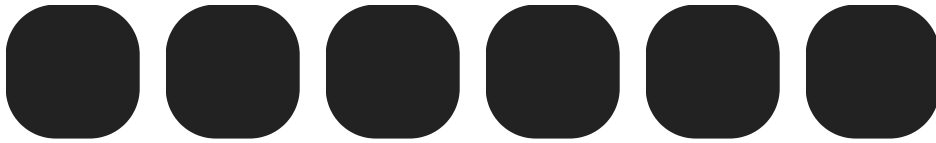

equipment.

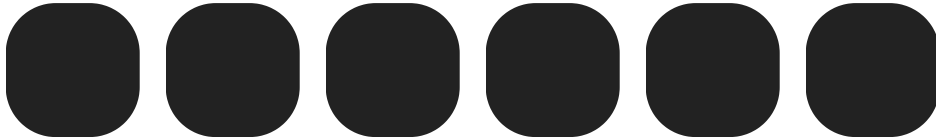

2016 Stoddard County Pageants Slated for October 9th
