ignited the offense, bringing home Josh Ellenburg.

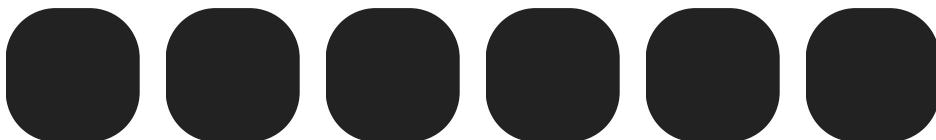
