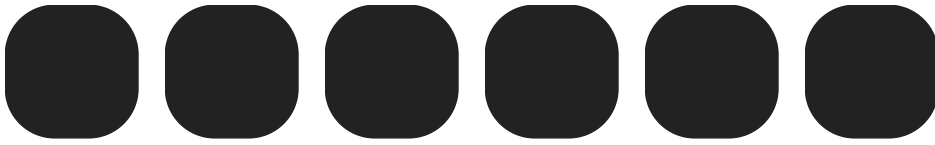
His future plans are to attend college and is undecided in a major at this time.

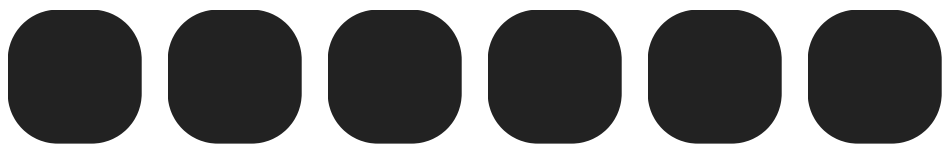
University, and a Masters in Professional Counseling from Argosy University.
