Bearcats Fall to Sharp Shooting Bluejays

Jason Jarrell also finished in double digits adding 12 points to the board. He had one 3-pointer.

The schedule does not get any easier for the Bearcats (0-1). On Friday evening they face another powerhouse, the Sikeston Bulldogs and on their turf. Next week it's another tough week as they take part in the SEMO Conference Tournament potentially facing Sikeston again as they are the #1 seed. 
