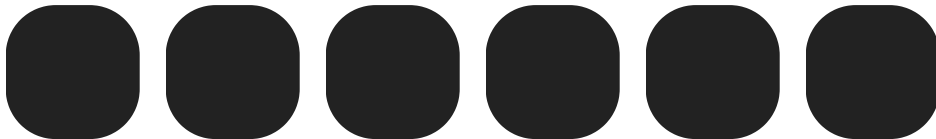
East Prairie will play in the fifth-place semifinal Wednesday at 4:00 p.m.

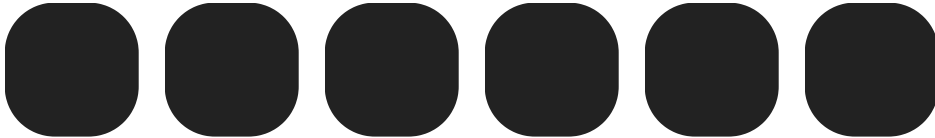
