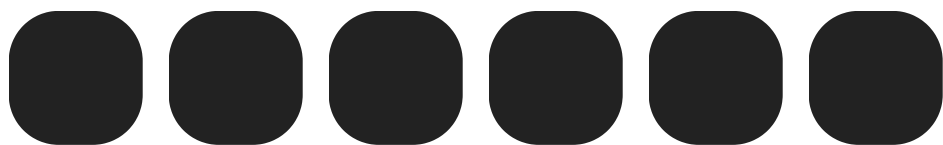

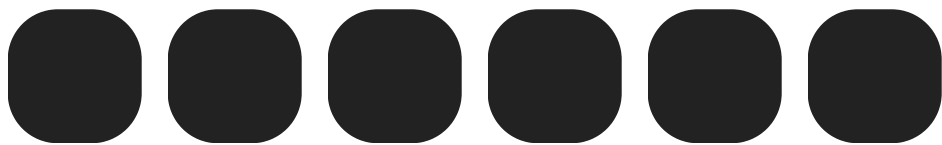
Funeral services will be conducted in the Rainey-Mathis Funeral Chapel on Friday, December 30, 2017 starting at 12:00 Noon.
