Rick Beard and Denny Riddle have refiled. The board positions are on a three year term.

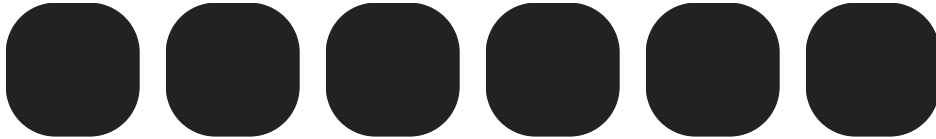
