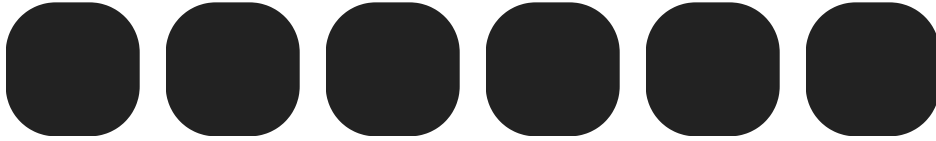
Garrett is the son of Roger and Sherry Medler.

Dexter, Missouri - The Dexter Lions Club recently presented a donation in the amount of \$500 to the Dexter Fire Department.

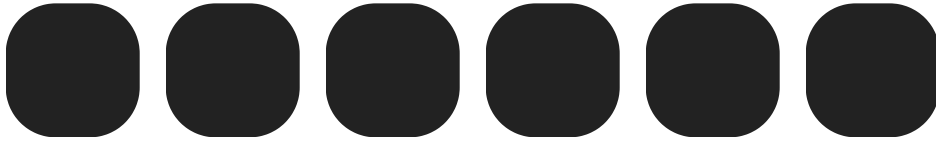
The money was raised from the Back the Blue Bulb sales at the Stoddard County Fair.

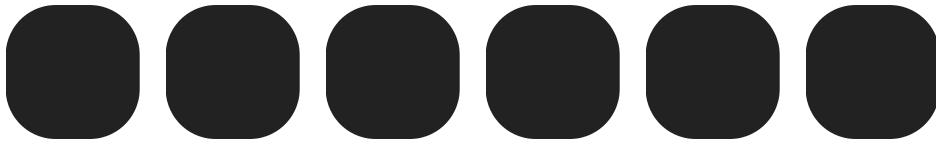
