### Women Legislators of Missouri Scholarship

**Jefferson City, Missouri** - Women Legislators of Missouri are encouraging young women, set to graduate from high school, to apply for a \$500 college scholarship. Each year the group selects one student from each of Missouri's congressional districts to receive the award. Members hope to spread the word about the scholarship opportunity so that female students from all parts of the state will apply.

“This is a great opportunity for any young woman who is interested in continuing her post graduate studies to receive some valuable financial assistance.” said Tila Hubrecht, R, Dexter.

The Women Legislators of Missouri Caucus created the senior scholarship program to provide financial assistance to students on the basis of leadership, academics and community service. Candidates must fill out an application and are required to submit a 500-word essay answering the question, “If you were a state legislator, what would you hope to accomplish and why?”

The submission deadline is Thursday, March 9, 2017.

He is a member of Future Farmers of America.

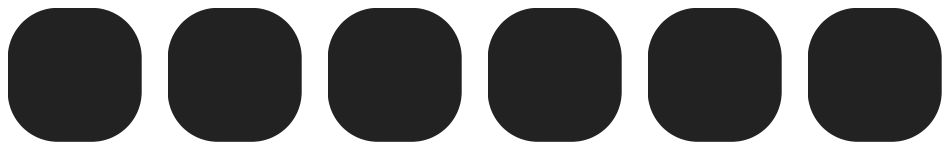
His career record in wrestling is 16-11.
