There will be a Masonic service at 8:00 PM Wednesday.

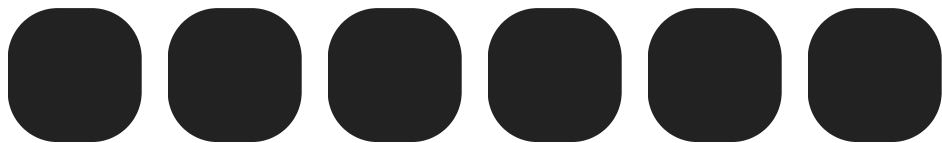
