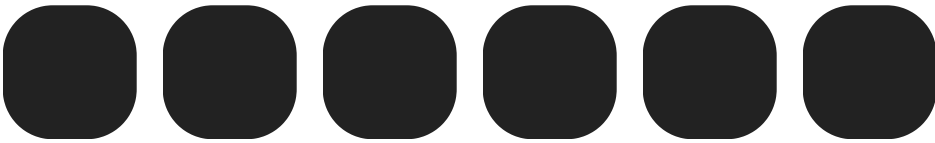

Southwest, Central, and the Middle School each received a little over \$1,700 each from the proceeds at the Book Fair.

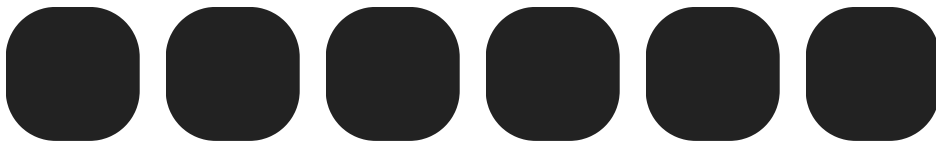
"We greatly appreciate the community and it is good to see where their money goes when they invest in fundraisers at the schools," commented Collier.
