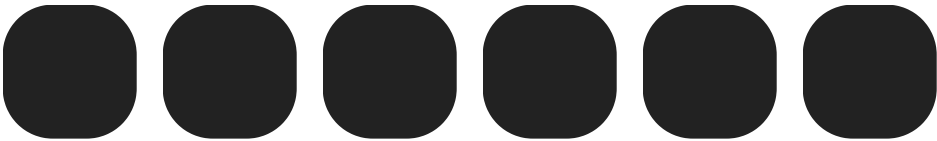
...FLOOD WATCH IN EFFECT THROUGH SATURDAY AFTERNOON

... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A \* FLOOD WATCH FOR PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING AREAS, IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, ALEXANDER, FRANKLIN, GALLATIN, HAMILTON, HARDIN, JACKSON, JOHNSON, MASSAC, POPE, PULASKI, SALINE, UNION, WHITE, AND WILLIAMSON. IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, BOLLINGER, BUTLER, CAPE GIRARDEAU, CARTER, PERRY MO, RIPLEY, SCOTT, STODDARD, AND WAYNE MO. \* THROUGH SATURDAY AFTERNOON \* WIDESPREAD RAINFALL AMOUNTS FROM 2 TO 3 INCHES HAVE OCCURRED OVER PARTS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI OVER THE PAST 24 HOURS, WITH 1 TO 2 INCHES ELSEWHERE IN THE WATCH AREA. RAIN IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH SATURDAY. THERE MAY BE SOME BREAKS IN THE RAIN, BUT THERE WILL ALSO BE PERIODS OF HEAVY RAIN THAT WILL BE CAPABLE OF FLOODING CREEKS AND LOW-LYING AREAS. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... A FLOOD WATCH MEANS THERE IS A POTENTIAL FOR FLOODING BASED ON CURRENT FORECASTS. YOU SHOULD MONITOR LATER FORECASTS AND BE ALERT FOR POSSIBLE FLOOD WARNINGS. THOSE LIVING IN AREAS PRONE TO FLOODING SHOULD BE PREPARED TO TAKE ACTION SHOULD FLOODING DEVELOP.

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a FREEZE WARNING for Stoddard County, Missouri.

**FREEZE WARNING FROM 10PM CDT MON UNTIL 10AM CDT THU**

**...FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 10 AM CDT THURSDAY**

**... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 10 AM CDT THURSDAY. \* TEMPERATURE**

**... LOWS TONIGHT... SUB FREEZING... 26-31.**

**LOWS TUESDAY NIGHT..... 18-23**

**.. HARD FREEZE! LOWS WEDNESDAY NIGHT... 21-26.. HARD FREEZE!**

**\* IMPACTS... FRUIT TREES IN BLOOM OR BUDDED OUT WILL BE DAMAGED BY HARD FREEZE TEMPERATURES. OTHER SIMILAR EARLY SPRING PLANTS THAT ARE AHEAD OF SCHEDULE WITH THEIR BLOOMS AND BUDS WILL LIKEWISE EXPERIENCE SIMILAR DAMAGE.**

**FREEZING TEMPERATURES WILL BE REACHED TONIGHT BUT THE REAL HARD AND DAMAGING FREEZE WILL BE TUESDAY NIGHT AND AGAIN WEDNESDAY NIGHT. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS**

... A FREEZE WARNING MEANS SUB-FREEZING TEMPERATURES ARE IMMINENT OR HIGHLY LIKELY. THESE CONDITIONS WILL KILL CROPS AND OTHER SENSITIVE VEGETATION. TAKE YOUR NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS THAT YOU CAN NOW, BECAUSE THIS IS A KILLING HARD FREEZE THAT IS COMING.

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement until 4:30 a.m. Saturday morning,

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4:30AM CST SAT

..LIGHT SNOWS POSSIBLE LATE TONIGHT INTO SATURDAY EVENING

... ARCTIC AIR WILL CONTINUE TO SURGE THROUGH THE AREA TONIGHT.

MEANWHILE, AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL DROP SOUTHEASTWARD INTO THE REGION, BRINGING A GOOD CHANCE OF SOME LIGHT SNOW TO MUCH OF THE REGION VERY LATE TONIGHT INTO SATURDAY EVENING.

IF TEMPERATURES CAN WARM INTO THE MIDDLE OR UPPER 30S THE SNOW MAY MIX WITH OR CHANGE TO RAIN OVER PORTIONS OF THE REGION IN THE AFTERNOON.

RELATIVELY WARM GROUND AND ROAD CONDITIONS ALONG WITH TEMPERATURES HOVERING JUST ABOVE FREEZING SHOULD MINIMIZE TRAVEL IMPACTS THROUGH THE DAY.

HOWEVER, IF THE SNOW COMES DOWN HARD AT TIMES, OR IF SNOW LASTS MUCH PAST SUNSET WHEN TEMPERATURES FALL INTO THE 20S FOR GOOD, THERE COULD BE SOME IMPACTS, ESPECIALLY ON ELEVATED ROADWAYS.

ALL PRECIPITATION SHOULD EXIT THE REGION BY MIDNIGHT

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service has issued a FREEZE WARNING from 10 p.m. Friday until 8 a.m. Saturday for Stoddard County.

**FREEZE WARNING FROM 10PM CST FRI UNTIL 8AM CST SAT**

**...FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 8 AM CST SATURDAY**

**... THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A FREEZE WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING TO 8 AM CST SATURDAY. \* TEMPERATURE**

**...MID 20S ALONG THE I-64 CORRIDOR TO AROUND 30 NEAR THE BORDER REGION OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI. \* IMPACTS**

**...THE FORECAST TEMPERATURES WILL LIKELY DAMAGE FRUIT TREES, ESPECIALLY THOSE TREES THAT HAVE ALREADY BUDDED OUT SUCH AS PEACH TREES. OTHER PLANTS THAT ARE SIMILARLY AHEAD OF SCHEDULE FOR THE SPRING GROWING SEASON COULD ALSO BE IMPACTED. PLEASE TAKE PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT ANY SENSITIVE PLANTS. THE COLD NIGHTS WILL LIKELY CONTINUE WELL INTO NEXT WEEK. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS**

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 4AM CST FRI

...LIGHT SNOWS POSSIBLE SATURDAY INTO SATURDAY EVENING

... ARCTIC AIR WILL SURGE THROUGH THE AREA LATE TONIGHT THROUGH FRIDAY.

MEANWHILE, AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL DROP SOUTHEASTWARD INTO THE REGION, BRINGING A GOOD CHANCE OF SOME LIGHT SNOW TO MUCH OF THE REGION SATURDAY INTO SATURDAY EVENING.

IF TEMPERATURES CAN WARM INTO THE MIDDLE OR UPPER 30s THE SNOW MAY MIX WITH OR CHANGE TO RAIN OVER PORTIONS OF THE REGION IN THE AFTERNOON.

RELATIVELY WARM GROUND AND ROAD CONDITIONS ALONG WITH TEMPERATURES HOVERING AROUND OR JUST ABOVE FREEZING SHOULD MINIMIZE TRAVEL IMPACTS THROUGH THE DAY.

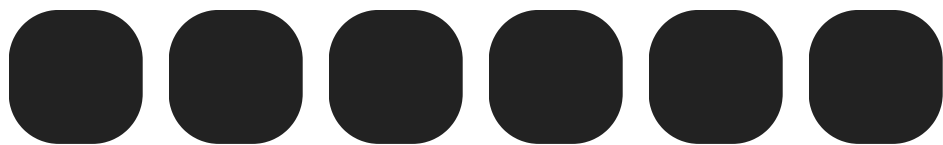

## Severe Storms Expected to Move into Southeast Missouri

Severe Storms Expected to Move into Southeast Missouri

**Stoddard County, Missouri** - The National Weather Service has issued a Special Weather Statement for Stoddard County until 8 p.m.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 8PM CST THU

...STRONG TO SEVERE STORMS EXPECTED TO MOVE INTO SOUTHEAST MISSOURI BETWEEN 5 PM AND 6 PM CST

... SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS ACROSS WEST AND SOUTH CENTRAL MISSOURI WERE BEGINNING TO ACCELERATE TOWARD SOUTHEAST MISSOURI THIS AFTERNOON.

THESE THUNDERSTORMS ARE STARTING TO GROUP TOGETHER INTO A SMALL LINE

...CURRENTLY MOVING SOUTHEAST NEAR 50 MPH.

ALTHOUGH HAIL WILL BE A HAZARD, A MORE WIDESPREAD SWATH OF DAMAGING STRAIGHT LINE WINDS, EXCEEDING 70 MPH AT TIMES, WILL BE POSSIBLE FROM THE LATE AFTERNOON AND INTO THE EARLY EVENING.

THE LEADING EDGE OF THE STORMS COULD REACH THE WESTERN BORDER OF WAYNE AND CARTER COUNTIES BETWEEN 5 PM AND 515 PM CST.

THESE STORMS WILL LIKELY INTENSIFY AND ACCELERATE FURTHER AS THE MOVE INTO SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, POSSIBLY REACHING NEAR A CAIRO ILLINOIS TO NEW MADRID MISSOURI LINE NEAR 7 PM CST.

IF YOU LIVE OR ARE PLANNING TRAVEL INTO SOUTHEAST MISSOURI LATE THIS AFTERNOON AND THROUGH SUNSET, BE PREPARED TO SEEK SHELTER WHEN THREATENING STORMS APPROACH YOUR AREA.

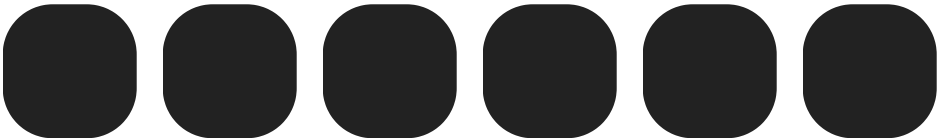
THE STRONG STORMS MAY WORK INTO PARTS OF EXTREME SOUTHWEST AND SOUTHERN ILLINOIS DURING THE EVENING.

THESE STORMS WILL LIKELY WORK MOVE INTO THE PURCHASE AREA OF WEST KENTUCKY AFTER DARK. STAY TUNED AND MONITOR TO NOAA WEATHER RADIO, COMMERCIAL TELEVISION AND RADIO, SOCIAL MEDIA, AND MOBILE DEVICES FOR THE LATEST WATCHES, WARNINGS, AND STATEMENTS.
