The contractor for the project was Brown Construction Company.

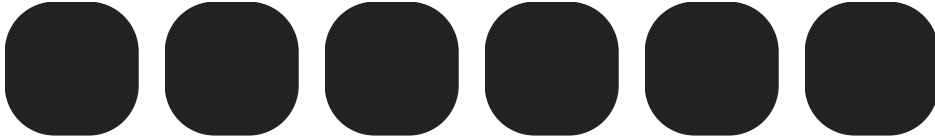
