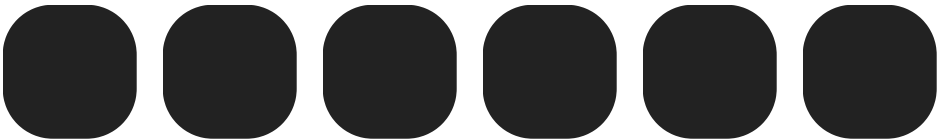
Counts has 26 years in education and the last 11 years he has been in the role of administrator.
