FLASH FLOOD WARNING FROM 5:26PM CDT SAT UNTIL 8:30PM CDT SAT THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A * FLASH FLOOD WARNING FOR... BOLLINGER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... MISSISSIPPI COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... SCOTT COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... WAYNE COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... STODDARD COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... * UNTIL 830 PM CDT * AT 525 PM CDT, DOPPLER RADAR INDICATED NUMEROUS THUNDERSTORMS PRODUCING HEAVY RAIN ACROSS THE WARNED AREA. Special Weather Alert Issued, Possible Hail

Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Special Weather Alert.

...Small hail possible with isolated thunderstorms in southeast Missouri and extreme southwest Kentucky this afternoon...

A southward moving upper level disturbance will continue spur the development of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms this afternoon over parts of southeast Missouri and extreme southwest Kentucky this afternoon.

Given the very cold air aloft associated with this weather disturbance, some of the stronger rain showers and isolated thunderstorms may produce brief, but small, hail at times.

A public report of one quarter to one half inch hail was noted near Ellsinore, along Highway F.

As the sun gradually sets this afternoon and into the early evening, the coverage and intensity of the showers and isolated thunderstorms should diminish quickly.

Most of the rain activity should completely dissipate by the middle of the evening across the area.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 7PM CDT WED ...SMALL HAIL POSSIBLE WITH ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND EXTREME SOUTHWEST KENTUCKY THIS AFTERNOON... A SOUTHWARD MOVING UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL CONTINUE SPUR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SCATTERED SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS THIS AFTERNOON OVER PARTS OF SOUTHEAST MISSOURI AND EXTREME SOUTHWEST KENTUCKY THIS AFTERNOON.

GIVEN THE VERY COLD AIR ALOFT ASSOCIATED WITH THIS WEATHER DISTURBANCE, SOME OF THE STRONGER RAIN SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE BRIEF, BUT SMALL, HAIL AT TIMES. AT 302 PM CDT, A PUBLIC REPORT OF ONE QUARTER TO ONE HALF INCH HAIL WAS NOTED NEAR ELLSINORE, ALONG HIGHWAY F. AS THE SUN GRADUALLY SETS THIS AFTERNOON AND INTO THE EARLY EVENING, THE COVERAGE AND INTENSITY OF THE SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS SHOULD DIMINISH QUICKLY. MOST OF THE RAIN ACTIVITY SHOULD COMPLETELY DISSIPATE BY THE MIDDLE OF THE EVENING ACROSS THE AREA.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 5AM CDT FR

...GUSTY NORTH WINDS STARTING TONIGHT AND INCREASING FRIDAY

... A STRONG LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM WILL MOVE JUST TO OUR EAST OVERNIGHT.

THIS WILL BRING NORTHERLY WINDS TO THE REGION TONIGHT OF 15 MPH WITH GUSTS AS HIGH AS 25 MPH.

THE MAIN AREAS AFFECTED WILL BE NORTH AND WEST OF THE OHIO RIVER. FRIDAY THESE WINDS WILL SPREAD EAST ACROSS THE ENTIRE AREA AND INTENSIFY. FRIDAY WE EXPECT WINDS TO REMAIN NORTHERLY BUT INCREASE TO 15 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS AS HIGH AS 35 MPH.

THIS WILL CREATE HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS FOR VEHICLES TRAVELING ALONG WEST OR EAST BOUND TRAVELERS AND ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE IN HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES.

IN ADDITION, CONSIDERING ALL THE SOAKED SOIL, IT WOULD BE MUCH EASIER TO UPROOT A TREE OR TWO. ESPECIALLY ANY THAT ARE ALREADY COMPROMISED FROM RECENT WIND EVENTS.



Stoddard County, Missouri - The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT until 3:30 p.m. Tuesday.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 3:30PM CDT TUE

...MORE RAINFALL HEADING INTO THE REGION.

.. ANOTHER STRONG, SLOW-MOVING STORM SYSTEM WILL BRING MORE MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINFALL TO THE REGION WEDNESDAY THROUGH THURSDAY. 1 TO 3 INCHES OF RAIN IS FORECAST, WITH THE HEAVIEST RAINS FALLING OVER AREAS FROM PERRYVILLE MISSOURI THROUGH PINCKNEYVILLE, MT VERNON AND FAIRFIELD ILLINOIS.

A LARGE MAJORITY OF THIS RAIN IS EXPECTED WEDNESDAY NIGHT INTO THURSDAY MORNING, WHEN SOME EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE POSSIBLE. WHILE THESE RAINFALL AMOUNTS PALE IN COMPARISON TO THE HEAVY RAINS THAT FELL OVER THE WEEKEND, THEY WILL SERVE TO AGGRAVATE EXISTING FLOODING AND POSSIBLY LEAD TO NEW FLOODING PROBLEMS. MANY RIVER FORECASTS ACROSS THE AREA WILL BE IMPACTED, AT LEAST WITH A PROLONGED FLOOD WAVE, IF NOT NEW OR HIGHER CRESTS. RIVER FORECASTS LATER TODAY SHOULD INCORPORATE MOST OF THIS FORECAST RAINFALL.
