THIS ADVISORY INCLUDES SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHWEST ILLINOIS, AND FAR WESTERN KENTUCKY. THE AREA IS ALONG AND WEST OF A LINE FROM MOUNT VERNON ILLINOIS TO PADUCAH AND MAYFIELD KENTUCKY.



... WITH HIGH TEMPERATURES AROUND 90 DEGREES, HEAT INDEX VALUES OF 100 TO 105 DEGREES ARE EXPECTED TUESDAY AFTERNOON ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, FAR WEST KENTUCKY AND EXTREME SOUTHERN ILLINOIS.

BY WEDNESDAY, AFTERNOON HIGHS WILL REACH THE LOWER TO MIDDLE 90S. WHEN COMBINED WITH HIGH HUMIDITY, THESE CONDITIONS WILL PRODUCE HEAT INDICES OF AT LEAST 100 TO 105 DEGREES ACROSS THE ENTIRE REGION. HEAT INDEX VALUES IN SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, FAR WEST

...HEAT ADVISORY IN EFFECT FROM 8 PM SATURDAY TO 7 PM CDT SUNDAY

...THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED AN EXCESSIVE HEAT WARNING, WHICH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 8 PM CDT SATURDAY. A HEAT ADVISORY HAS ALSO BEEN ISSUED. THIS HEAT ADVISORY IS IN EFFECT FROM 8 PM SATURDAY TO 7 PM CDT SUNDAY. THE AREA COVERED BY THIS WARNING INCLUDES SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, AND EXTREME WESTERN KENTUCKY FROM PADUCAH WEST.
