Dexter, Missouri - The Stoddard County Nutrition center is in need of volunteers to deliver meals in Bernie, Dexter, and Bloomfield.

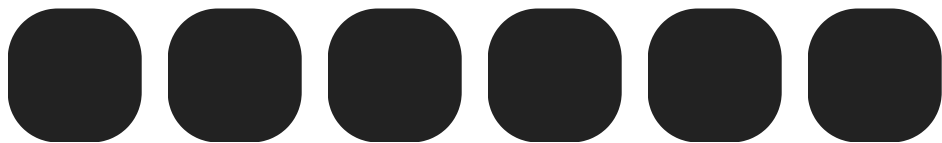

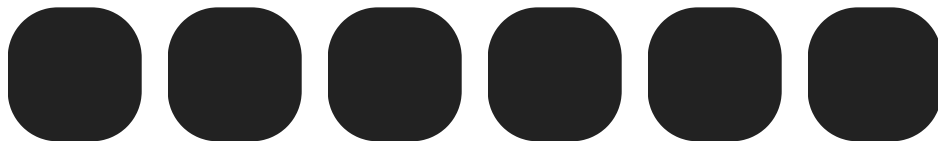
