Brown also hit a towering 2-run home run.

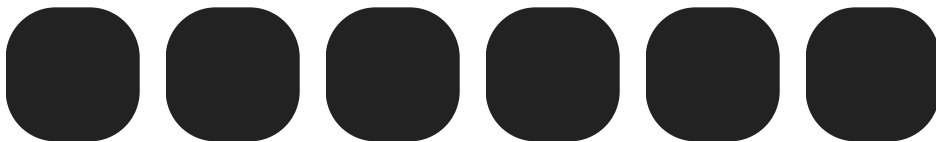
Nate Dillinger earned the win pitching 4 innings, allowing 0 hits and 0 runs. He also struck out 8 and walked only one player.
