On Friday it's Red & Black Spirit Day - Wear your favorite Bearcat shirt or red and black.

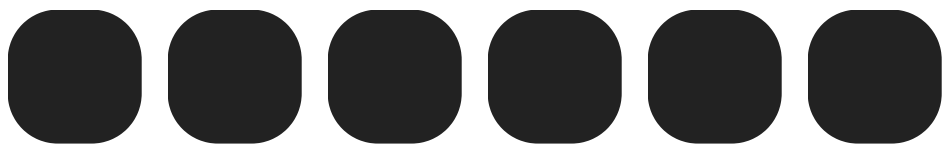
Pep rally will be at 2:15 for kindergarten, first grade, and second grade.

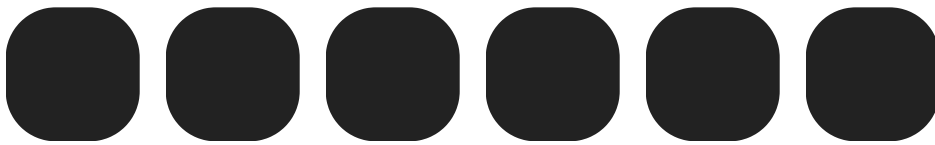
