Her father: Donald Ray Trout preceded her in death.

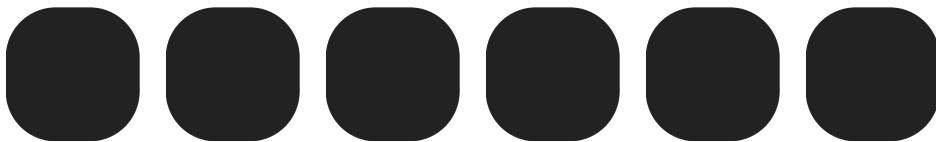
Visitation will begin at 10:00 am on Saturday at White-Sanders Funeral Home in Fisk.
