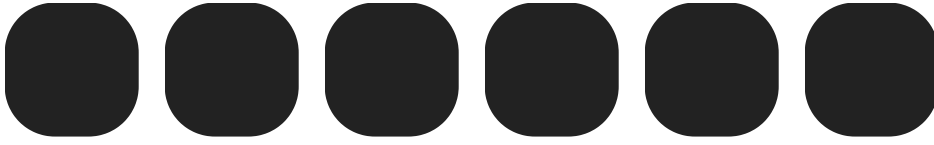
Maci has been Top 10% 3 years and was Academic All State her junior year.

The Board approved the Amendment Revision #1 to the Budget and approved the monthly Financial Statement.

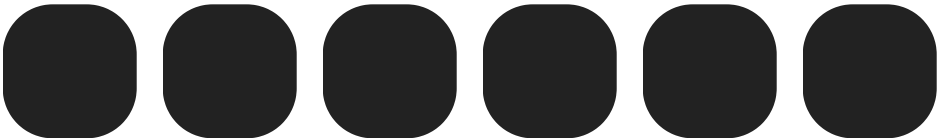
The Board approved adding Charles Marcum, Melinda Babb and Taylure Harris to the substitute teacher list.

Faith Felice is a 3rd grader in Mrs. Arnold’s class. Mrs. Arnold referred Faith for always being very respectful and working hard every day.

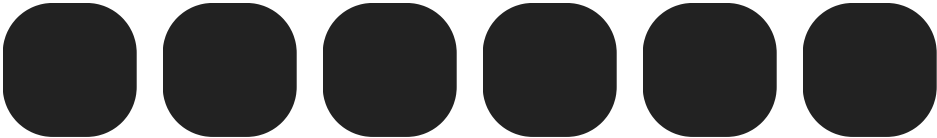
