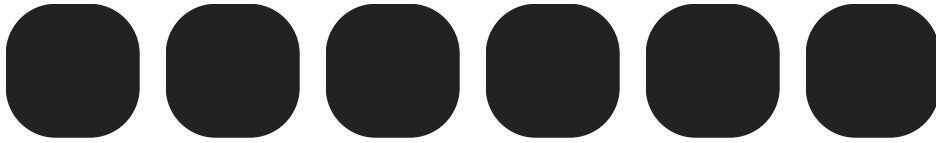

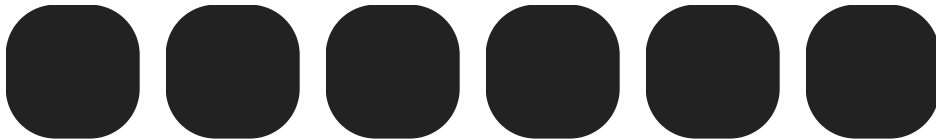

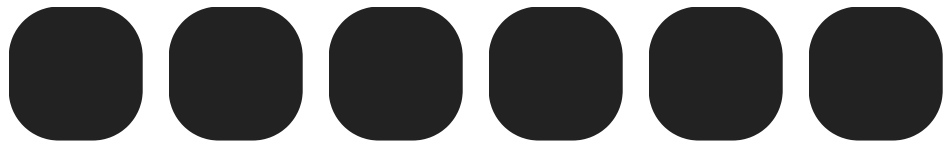
Megan was a Top 10% academic student her freshman year and Academic All State in Volleyball and Basketball her junior year.
