There will be plenty to eat and everyone is welcome.



All Hallows' Eve Worship Service at First United Methodist Church

All Saints Day is a church festival that recalls the faith and witness of the women and men who have gone before us. The night before All Saints (or All Hallows) became known as All Hallows Eve or Halloween.
