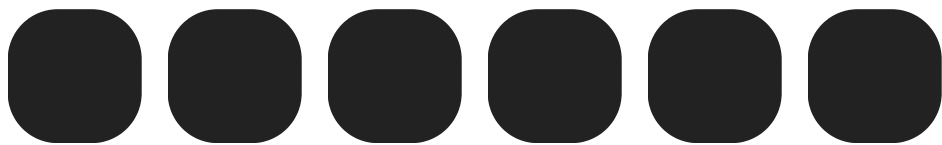
Interment will follow in the Dudley Cemetery.
