Friends may call at the Rainey-Mathis Funeral Home on Sunday, January 28, 2018 from 4:00 to 6:00 PM.

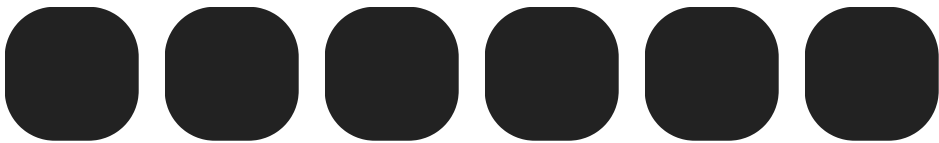
