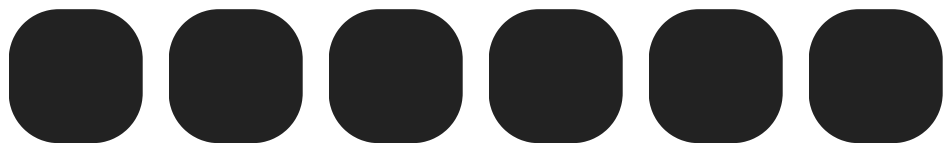

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by one brother in infancy.

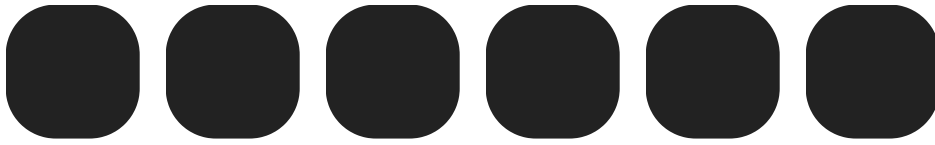
