Stoddard County, The National Weather Service in Paducah, Kentucky has issued a Flash Flood Warning for Stoddard County, Missouri.

FLASH FLOOD WARNING FROM 3:30PM CST SAT UNTIL 8:30PM CST SAT THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN PADUCAH HAS ISSUED A * FLASH FLOOD WARNING FOR

... BOLLINGER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... CARTER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... RIPLEY COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... STODDARD COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... BUTLER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI... BUTLER COUNTY IN SOUTHEASTERN MISSOURI...

* UNTIL 830 PM CST * AT 323 PM CST, SOME FLOODING OF ROADS AND LOW-LYING AREAS WAS ALREADY OCCURRING IN THE WARNED AREA. RAINFALL AMOUNTS OF CLOSE TO 5 INCHES HAVE FALLEN OVER THE PAST FOUR DAYS OR SO.

THUNDERSTORMS WITH WIDESPREAD HEAVY RAIN WILL CONTINUE TO MOVE EAST ACROSS THE WARNED AREA THROUGH EARLY THIS EVENING. FLASH FLOODING IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN SHORTLY. ADDITIONAL RAINFALL AMOUNTS OF 1 TO 3 INCHES ARE LIKELY IN THE WARNED AREA OVER THE NEXT FEW HOURS.

THIS HEAVY RAIN WILL FALL ON SATURATED GROUND, CAUSING WATER LEVELS TO RISE VERY QUICKLY.

IN HILLY TERRAIN THERE ARE HUNDREDS OF LOW WATER CROSSINGS WHICH ARE POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS IN HEAVY RAIN. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CROSS FLOODED ROADS. FIND AN ALTERNATE ROUTE.

THE FLOOD WATCH CONTINUES FOR * PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA, WESTERN KENTUCKY, AND SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING AREAS, IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, ALEXANDER, EDWARDS, FRANKLIN, GALLATIN, HAMILTON, HARDIN, JACKSON, JEFFERSON, JOHNSON, MASSAC, PERRY IL, POPE, PULASKI, SALINE, UNION, WABASH, WAYNE IL, WHITE, AND WILLIAMSON.

IN SOUTHWEST INDIANA, GIBSON, PIKE, POSEY, SPENCER, VANDERBURGH, AND WARRICK. ...HEAVY RAINFALL EXPECTED THROUGH SATURDAY NIGHT ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WEST KENTUCKY... MULTIPLE WEATHER DISTURBANCES WILL MOVE ACROSS THE FOUR STATE REGION THROUGH SATURDAY NIGHT AND BRING REPEATED BOUTS OF RAIN, MODERATE TO HEAVY AT TIMES. ... WINDS WILL AVERAGE 15 TO 30 MPH OUT OF THE SOUTH OR SOUTHWEST, AND GUSTS WILL FOR THE MOST PART, BE IN THE 30 TO 40 MPH RANGE, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY.

HOWEVER, THERE MAY BE AN ISOLATED EXCEPTION OR TWO, WHERE A GUST COULD BE AS HIGH AS 45 MPH OR MORE.

THIS WILL OCCUR WHERE THE CLOUDS BREAK TO FULL SUNSHINE, AND SHOULD BE AN INSTANTANEOUS OR SHORT LIVED GUST THAT AVERAGES ABOUT 10 MPH HIGHER THAN MOST GUSTS.

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT UNTIL 9PM CST SUN

...A LIGHT WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION POSSIBLE THIS EVENING

... RADAR RETURNS CONTINUE TO TAKE SHAPE ACROSS SOUTHEAST MISSOURI, FAR SOUTHERN ILLINOIS, SOUTHWEST INDIANA AND WESTERN KENTUCKY.

WE NOW BELIEVE A VERY LIGHT WINTRY MIX OF PRECIPITATION WILL CONTINUE TO EXPAND EAST ACROSS THIS REGION EARLY TONIGHT. THERE IS STILL SOME UNCERTAINTY WITH THIS EVENT.

PRECIPITATION AMOUNTS SHOULD REMAIN LIGHT IF THE ACTIVITY REALLY GETS GOING. HOWEVER, WITH TEMPERATURES BELOW FREEZING, ANY LIGHT ACCUMULATION OF FREEZING RAIN OR SLEET COULD RESULT IN THE DEVELOPMENT SLICK SPOTS ON AREA ROADS, BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES, INCLUDING UNTREATED ROAD SURFACES.

WE MAY SEE ALL FORMS OF PRECIPITATION, INCLUDING LIGHT SLEET, LIGHT FREEZING RAIN AND DRIZZLE, AND LIGHT SNOW. SHOULD IMPACTS BECOME MORE PROMINENT, AN UPGRADE TO A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY MAY BE REQUIRED.
