Pamela is married with three children and three step children. She has 14 wonderful grandchildren.

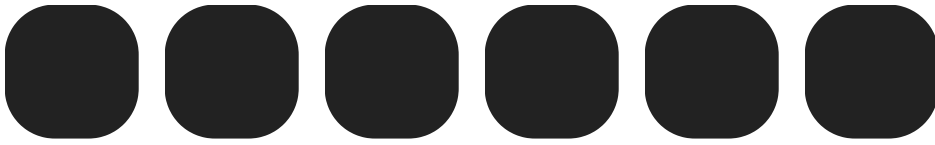
