B-25 "Maid in the Shade" to Visit Cape Regional Airport

One of the most iconic airplanes from World War II, B-25 Mitchell “Maid in the Shade,” will make a stop at the Cape Girardeau Regional Airport June 18-24 as part of its Summer Flying Legends of Victory Tour across the U.S. and Canada. The tour is made possible by the volunteers of the non-profit 501(c)3 Arizona Commemorative Air Force Museum.

Ride reservations and tours (fees apply) are open to the public. Tours will be available on Monday from 2-6 p.m., Tuesday through Thursday from 9 a.m.-2 p.m., and Friday through Sunday from 2-6 p.m. Rides are available on Friday through Sunday from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. Cost to tour is \$10 per person or \$20 for a family of four. Flights begin around \$325 each

Nearly 10,000 B-25s were produced, and the B-25 Mitchell “Maid in the Shade” is one of 34 still flying today. The aircraft was used in America’s first large-scale bombing offensive in the Philippines.

Dexter, Missouri - The City of Dexter's annual Fourth of July Fireworks Display is slated for Wednesday, July 4, 2018 at dusk (around 9:00 p.m.) at East City Park. Sunset is 8:22 p.m. on Wednesday, July 4th for Dexter.

S&N Display Fireworks from Lincoln, Illinois will provide the pyrotechnics again this year.

In case of rain on Wednesday, the fireworks show will be held on Thursday, July 5, 2018. The Fire Chief will let the ShowMe Times know if there is a cancellation or change and will be announced on Facebook, Twitter and with a ShowMe Times text alert (if you haven't signed up please do so!).

The event is free and open to public.

"It will be in the same spot as last year. The soccer fields and baseball/softball fields will be roped off, but there is plenty of parking at the fairgrounds, south of the ball fields, at

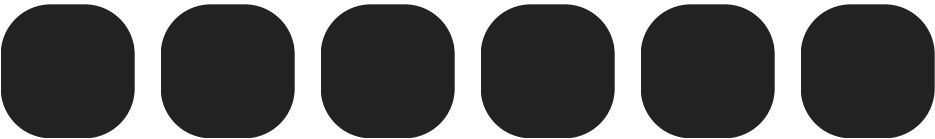
the aquatic center, and around the levee," commented Mark Stidham, Dexter City Administrator.

The city ordinance prohibits the shooting of fireworks inside the city limits however that will be waived on Wednesday, July 4th to allow residents a chance to celebrate the holiday. Fireworks are also allowed at the park prior to and after the official city display. If rain cancels the fireworks display on the 4th residents will be able to shoot fireworks on the 5th only if cancelled!!!

Fake \$100 Bills Popping Up in Dexter

Dexter, Missouri - The Dexter police department is urging businesses to be careful when accepting \$100 bills, after reports of at least three incidents in the Dexter area.

According to Dexter Police Chief Trevor Pulley, "We have had three since May 21, 2018 at local businesses."

Businesses should be proactive when taking money over the counter of any denomination higher than a \$20, but be especially cautious when taking \$50 or \$100 dollar bills.

There are a number of security features on bills issued by the US Federal Reserve, but Pulley suggests that businesses should focus on the security band that is to the left of the portrait on the front of the bill running vertically. According to uscurrency.gov, the band should be visible if you backlight the bill, and will have "USA" and the number "100" on it as well, alternating on both sides of the strip.

Other security features, according to uscurrency.gov, include a watermark of Benjamin Franklin to the right of the portrait, color-shifting ink on the "100" in the corner of the bill, a 3-D security ribbon that runs to the right of the portrait that alternate both bells and a "100" when you move the bill side-to-side, among other features.

If you feel you have received a counterfeit \$100 bill please contact your local police department immediately.

Dexter PD Press Release Regarding Business Burglaries

Dexter, Missouri - Many business owners can put their mind at ease as Dexter Police Department has made an arrest after a lengthy investigation with regards to recent burglaries. We would like to thank our police officers who assisted in the investigation and worked many long hours through evidence, tips, etc to make this arrest.

Below is a press release from the Dexter Police Department.

Jacob Jackson of Dexter, Missouri was arrested by officer's with the Malden Police Department. During the investigation and interviews with Jackson, he admitted to being involved in several business burglaries in Dexter.

Detective Lt. Cory Mills and Detective Sgt. Eddie Holloway assisted in the investigation and completed and provided warrant affidavits to the Stoddard County Prosecutor. On May 23rd, 2018 a warrant was issued for Jackson, charging him with 9 counts of Burglary in the 2nd Degree (Class D Felony), 6 Count of Stealing (Class D Felony) 2 Counts of Stealing (Class A Misdemeanor) and 4 Counts of Property Damage (Class A Misdemeanor). Bond was set at \$500,000.00 Cash.
