## A-State Announces 2018 Spring Chancellor and Dean Lists

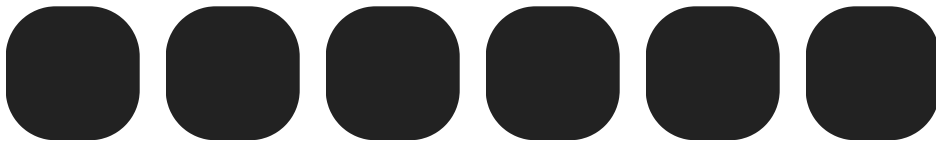
Trey Johnson, a sophomore at DHS, built this table as one of his projects in his shop class. Students were able to take home their projects at the end of the school season.
