Wednesday, August 26th - Cheeseburger or catfish, sweet potato fries, turnips, hush puppies, and chocolate pudding.

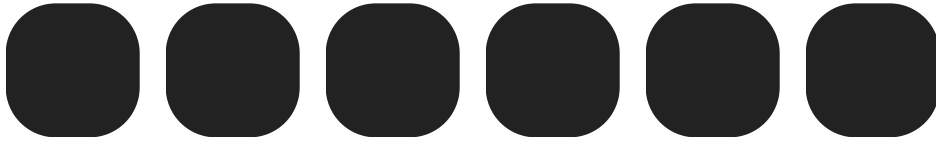
Thursday, August 27th - Taco salad, black bean salsa, cinnamon chips, and fruit.

Dexter, Missouri - Dave Ellinghouse was recently recognized for his tenure on the Keller Library Board of Directors.

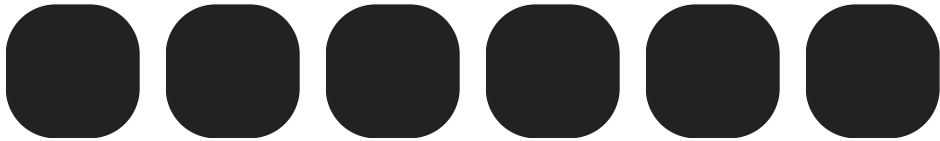
Debbie Vanslyke, pictured on the his right, is the outgoing board president.

If rain the pageant will be held at the Harvest Assembly of God Church.

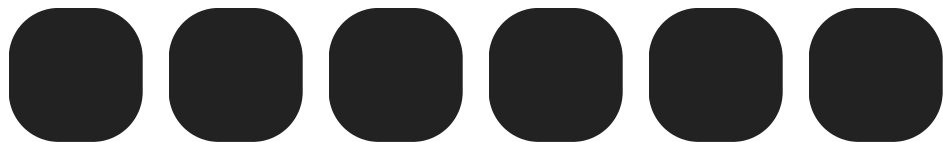
