Presidential Proclamation on the Death of Senator John McCain - Flags to Fly Half-Staff

AUGUST 27TH 2018 BY DEE LOFLIN

Presidential Proclamation on the Death of Senator John McCain - Flags to Fly Half-Staff

As a mark of respect for the memory and longstanding service of Senator John Sidney McCain III, I hereby order, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, that the flag of the United States shall be flown at half-staff at the White House and upon all public buildings and grounds, at all military posts and naval stations, and on all naval vessels of the Federal Government in the District of Columbia and throughout the United States and its Territories and possessions until sunset, on the day of interment. I also direct that the flag shall be flown at half-staff for the same period at all United States embassies, legations, consular offices, and other

facilities abroad, including all military facilities and naval vessels and stations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand this twenty-seventh day of August, in the year of our Lord two thousand eighteen, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and forty-third.

Interstate 55 in New Madrid County Reduced for Pavement Repairs

Southbound I-55 in New Madrid County will be reduced to one lane as contractor crews mill and fill the roadway from mile marker 43 to mile marker 42. Weather permitting, work will take place Tuesday, Aug. 28 and Wednesday, Aug. 29 with a lane reduction in place during operations and overnight.

Due to the location of construction, the Marston rest area will be closed Tuesday, Aug. 28 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. while crews complete the repairs. The rest area will reopen as construction continues to move south on I-55.

The work zone will be marked with signs. Motorists are urged to use extreme caution while traveling near the area.
