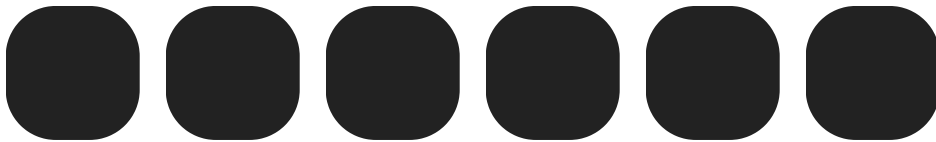

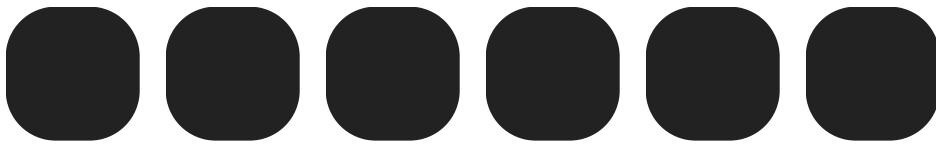

He is the son of Eric and Delisa Sitze.

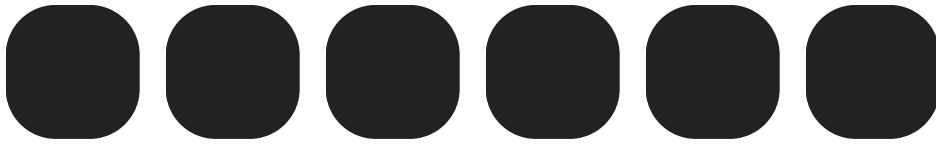
When asked what three words describe his sister, Dylan replied, “gullible, kind, and beautiful.”
