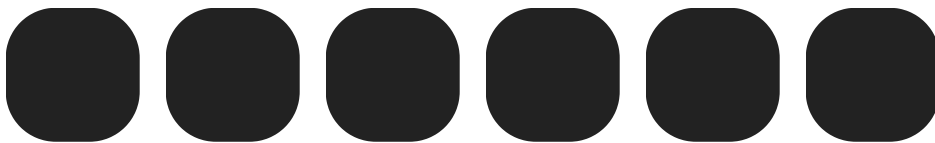

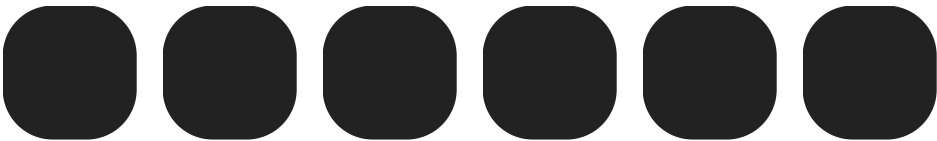

McKenzie always works hard and is kind to others.

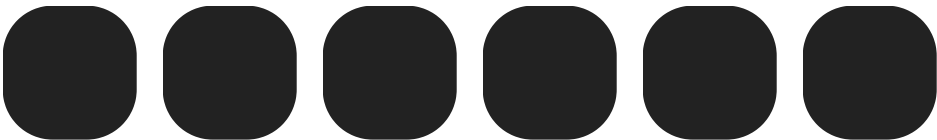
