


The articulation agreements establish clearly-defined pathways for Three Rivers students interested in transferring into bachelor's degree completion programs at Arkansas State.

Eureka Springs, Missouri - Dexter High School FBLA attended the Show Me Leadership Conference held at Six Flags on Saturday, October 6, 2018.


Thirty-eight members participated in open testing, listening to keynote speakers from the Six Flags staff as well as a behind-the-scenes tour of the haunted house.
